In this document you'll find information and prices for our holiday package, followed by other important travel information. Please note that the quoted price does not include domestic flights from Melbourne to Brisbane return as they are not currently available for booking. As more domestic flights come on line during 2021 we will secure these flights and inform you of the additional cost for these flights.

Our package prices are based on bulk purchase airfares with Air New Zealand. These fares have conditions that include final payment being completed no later than 14 May 2021. The quoted package includes a Seat and Bag airfare. If you would like a meal and in-flight entertainment see information inside on airfare upgrade options. When you are ready to make a booking you can do this by completing the attached Reservation Form and payment of a non-refundable \$200 deposit, please see further information inside regarding conditions and cancellation penalties.



COVID-19 Norfolk Island Travel Pass

Please note you are currently required to complete an online **Norfolk Island Entry Pass** 72 to 24 hours prior to your travel date. You **MUST** complete this to be allowed to board your flight. While I will remind you about the need to do this in the week prior to your flight, please be aware that the responsibility to complete a Norfolk Island Entry Pass will be your own. Your flight will be accessible to obtain a Pass not prior to 72 hours prior to your flight at https://norfolkau.viewpointcloud.com/categories/1083 The Entry Pass can only be obtained online so if you don't have access to a computer, please arrange to use a friend or family members computer in the period 72-24 hours prior to your flight.

We have included current information on the Entry Pass and Norfolk Island's COVID-19 preparedness for receiving visitors on our website that you can access at www.norfolkislandtravelcentre.com/news/travel-to-norfolk-island-in-a-covid-19-environment I recommend checking in here on a regular basis as we will continually update as any changes occur.

Conditions/Cancellation Penalties

Please note non-refundable deposit of \$200 per person due upon booking. Final payment is due before 14 May 2021. Airfare is subject to availability and non-refundable after issue. Changes are permitted until day before departure however date/route changes can only be made within 7 days travel dates either side of your original booked travel dates. Amendments, upgrades and name changes are not permitted within 24 hours prior to departure. Payment of a change fee (per passenger) applies plus any applicable upgrade fees to cover the difference between the original fare and the new fare. Accommodation cancellation penalties apply within 90 days prior to travel. Within 60 days of travel, up to 100% cancellation fees may apply. We strongly recommend travel insurance to protect you in some instances for unforeseen cancellation.

Payment Options

Prices shown are in Australian dollars and are payable by personal or bank cheques or by direct deposit into our Commonwealth Bank account (please see bank details below). If you would prefer to pay by Visa or Mastercard, please add 1.5% to the total cost of your holiday package.

Domestic Travel Insurance

Please make sure to open the separate Attachment regarding insurance for your trip. It is strongly recommended that passengers be covered by adequate travel insurance for protection against amendment or cancellation costs, travel delay, luggage, rental vehicle insurance excess and accidental death and personal liability. For the purposes of travel insurance Norfolk Island is deemed to be a domestic destination. However please bear in mind your destination is an island, which is subject to aircraft diversion in extreme weather conditions. As airlines do not accept responsibility for flight delays or cancellations due to weather, passengers electing not to take travel insurance do so at their own risk for costs or losses sustained.

Check-in

Flights depart from the international terminal at Sydney and Brisbane airports. Check-in is required two hours prior to the scheduled departure time.

Airfare upgrade options

The above quotes are based on a "Seat & Bag" airfare. "Seat & Bag" includes: 1 checked bag up to 23kgs + up to 7kg carry-on baggage. Air New Zealand provides complimentary tea, coffee and water. If you feel peckish on the flight, you can purchase snacks or drinks from our Inflight Bites menu, using your credit card or voucher. You can enjoy TV shows, music and games through Air New Zealand's gate-to-gate, seat-back entertainment.

Or let us know if you would like to upgrade your airfare to the following...

"The Works" includes: 1 checked bag up to 23kgs + up to 7kg carry-on baggage.

During your flight, you'll be entertained with movies, games, music and TV shows through Air New Zealand's gate-to-gate, seat-back entertainment. As part of The Works option, you will receive full meal and beverage options. After you've enjoyed your meal, you have the choice of ordering extra drinks, free of charge, from your seat. There is also restricted seat select for Works ticket holders however extra charges could apply depending on your exact seating request.

Additional cost: \$30 per person per sector (i.e. \$60 per person per return flight to Norfolk Island)

"Works Deluxe" includes: You'll enjoy Premium check-in, priority baggage with 2 checked-in bags (up to 23kg each), and a carry-on bag (up to 7kg). In the air, you'll be treated to a neighbour free guarantee - we'll guarantee the seat next to you will be empty. During your flight, you'll be entertained with movies, games, music and TV shows through Air New Zealand's gate-to-gate, seat-back entertainment. With the Works Deluxe option, you will receive full meal and beverage options, bottle of mineral water, newspaper and noise-cancelling headphones. After you've enjoyed your meal, you have the choice of ordering extra drinks free of charge during your flight.

Additional cost: \$95 per person per sector (i.e. \$190 per person per return flight to Norfolk Island)

Please note: Works Deluxe fares in line with Air New Zealand fare conditions must be paid in full at time of booking, therefore a \$900 per person non-refundable deposit applies to all passengers wishing to upgrade to Works Deluxe.



When travelling on domestic flights connecting to Norfolk Island flights

For those passengers travelling on *Qantas, Virgin, REX and all other carriers* to connect in Sydney/Brisbane to a Norfolk Island flight:

- 1. Note minimum connection time between your domestic and international flight is minimum two hours.
- 2. Passengers check-in at the domestic terminal, luggage will be checked through to Sydney/Brisbane only.
- 3. Collect your luggage at the Sydney/Brisbane domestic terminal and transfer with your luggage to the international terminal via train or TBus at your own expense.
- 4. Upon arrival in the Sydney/Brisbane international terminal proceed to the Air New Zealand check-in counter for luggage check-in and your boarding pass to Norfolk Island.
- 5. Upon return from Norfolk Island all passengers must clear customs in Sydney/Brisbane, collect their luggage and clear quarantine. Proceed to the domestic terminal with your luggage via train or TBus (at your own expense) and check-in for your domestic flight.

Excess Baggage

Air New Zealand excess baggage policy for flights to/from Norfolk Island effective since 01 February 2013.

Please note the following information:

- All sporting equipment (carried in addition to the standard 23kg piece included in 'seat and bag' airfares) is now considered by the airline as an additional extra bag
- Note carriage of firearms is a separate to the above see Air New Zealand website for more information or contact Norfolk Island Travel Centre.
- Extra bags can be prepaid through Norfolk Island Travel Centre for \$60 for the first extra piece (per person). For your flights to and from Norfolk Island the total cost is \$120 per piece/per person. Please note: you will not be able to book additional bags on line as the booking will be a group booking, the extra baggage may not be allocated to your ticket.
- Or alternatively the extra bag can be paid for at time of check-in, please note this will be at higher cost of \$120 per extra first piece (per person). For your flights to and from Norfolk Island the total cost is \$240 per piece/per person.
- Also note any piece of baggage that weighs over 23kg but less than 32kg and/or exceeds the total linear dimensions (length+width+height) of 158cm (62") will be subject to a further overweight/oversize charge.

Passport and Visa requirements

Since 2016 travel to Norfolk Island from mainland Australia has been classed as domestic travel. However, all flights still depart from and arrive at the international terminal.

Australian passport holders:

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection advises anyone travelling between Norfolk Island and mainland Australia will be required to identify themselves. Although passports and visas are no longer mandatory for Australian citizens when travelling to Norfolk Island from Australia, a valid passport continues to be the preferred method of identification.

• We recommend travelling with a passport if you have one, however technically photographic identification for Australian citizens such as an Australian driver's licence, will be acceptable.



- It's important you provide us with your full name as it appears on your Passport or Drivers licence to ensure your ticket matches your ID document.
- Those without a passport may experience some delays with manual customs checks
- Those travelling without a passport should also be aware that in the event of a flight diversion e.g. due
 to inclement weather preventing the aircraft to land on the island, the flight could be diverted to New
 Zealand. Those passengers without an Australian or NZ passport will not be permitted to leave the
 transit area at Auckland airport.

Foreign passport holders and/or those travelling via New Zealand:

- Non-Australian citizens who hold a permanent resident visa are able to travel to Norfolk Island without further visa requirements but must use a passport as your form of identification.
- Normal Australian Customs and Immigration procedures will apply when entry is made from outside Australia (including New Zealand). A passport (valid on entry and departure) is necessary and a visa may be required for some foreign passports.
